Organisation and Presentation	20%
Understanding of Material	80%

Lectures and Journal Reviews will be evaluated primarily on how well students demonstrate familiarity with the lecture material. **The organisation and Presentation** grade will be evaluated based on how well the student has prepared the material and their ability to organise and link the components of the lecture. The **Understanding of Material** will be evaluated based on how well the student demonstrates an understanding of the material being presented. In some cases, there may be ideas or concepts that are not immediately clear to the student and in such cases, the student should (and is encouraged to) engage the class as a whole to explore and discuss the concepts.

Things to keep in mind: It is important to understand why equations are used, what they represent and how they may have limitations. In general, it should be possible for students to demonstrate complete understanding of the lecture notes. In contrast, the journal papers may have material that goes beyond the scope of this course; for this reason, students are not expected in all cases to have a full understanding of the paper. Rather, students should identify things they did not understand and bring those issues to the class where they can be discussed.
